FAATL AUTO ACCIDENT ON HIGH POINT ROAD

MISS ANNIE JACKSON KILLED LAST NIGHT WHEN MACHINE OVERTURNED.

Miss Annie Jackson, a young lady of this city, met almost instant death last night when an automobile in which she was riding turned turtle on the High Point road at a point about three miles from High Point. The accident occurred at 10 o'clock last night and Miss Jackson died before she could be rushed to a High Point hospital.

The machine was being driven toward High Point and it is reported that the driver lost control on the slippery road while turning a sharp curve. C. L. Hutchinson, reported terbe an occupant of the car, could not be found after the accident, and the extent of his injuries were not known, while Miss Nettie Lethco and a Mr. Cross, who were also occupants of the machine, received painful though not serious injuries. Mr. Cross was taken to High where a severe cut across his head was dressed, but it was not necessary for him to remain in the hospital. Miss Lethco was able to return to this city last night.

Miss Jackson was good: 30 years of age and was employed in a local cigar factory. She is a native of this county, her parents residing in Guilford, and she had been working in the city for only a few months. The body was brought to this city and will be conveyed to the home of her parents for burial.
